### Central Region

The Co-ordinator for the Central Region is the founder of the Indigenous Health Scholarships, PP Geoffrey Bailey, OAM. Geoff is a member of the Rotary Club of Mitcham in District 9520. Geoff is married to Nesta with three grown up children.

District 9830 has adopted the concept of a push-bike ride to Conference to raise awareness and funds for the Australian Rotary Health Research Fund.

Six cyclists rode to St Helens on the East Coast of Tasmania for DG Bob Sydes Conference in March. PDG Tony Hennessy and President John Dobson (Rotary Club of Wynyard) rode 400 kilometres of typical Tasmanian hills and valleys whilst President Ian Fenton and Assistant Governor Chris Westlake (Rotary Club of Youngtown) and Rotarian Steve Baldock (Rotary Club of Evandale) rode 220 kilometres from Launceston.

Assistant Governor Bill Friend joined the group for a quick 100 kilometre sprint to the finish!

The event started simply as a challenge from President John Dobson to ARHRF Director Tony Hennessy who, in a rash moment, accepted the challenge and began some serious training.

The other cyclists joined the ride and found some sponsors.

The Rotary Club of Deloraine provided a \$5,000 sponsorship for the ride and Carpet Choice sponsored AG Chris Westlake for \$1,000. Individuals provided the remainder of the sponsorship.

Accompanying vehicles were provided by Graeme Page, Bob Kay and Jade Hennessy.

Next year's event is already in planning but will be much bigger and much more formally organized. The objective will be to increase the sponsorship dramatically, to increase the number of riders and therefore have a direct impact on the health and fitness of Rotarians and community member in District 9830 Tasmania, "The most beautiful island on earth".

## ARHRF 'FUNDING PARTNERS' IN OTHER HEALTH AREAS

Under a new initiative from the Board of the ARHRF, a Rotary Club or Rotary District may form a partnership with the Australian Rotary Health Research Fund to jointly fund a research project grant or a research scholarship in an area of health that is not the current focus for the Fund.

### 3 year PhD Scholarship

A Rotary Club, a University and the Australian Rotary Health

Research Fund will jointly fund a PhD Scholarship.

If a Rotary Club agrees to contribute in 'Funding Partners' – scholarships – the university/s local to the Club will be contacted to help source a suitable scholar in the chosen area of health. Most universities in Australia have agreed in principle, to this proposal.

\$25,000 per annum per scholarship (for a three year commitment) is allocated: \$10,000 from the Rotary Club \$9,000 from the University; and \$6,000 from the Australian Rotary Health Research Fund

A three-year commitment is required for a scholarship. 10% of

The CommunityLIFE project is funded by the Department of Health and Ageing under the National Suicide Prevention Strategy.

The project is focusing on building community capacity and providing support to enable communities to run their own suicide prevention projects.

The project has established a website at [www.community-life.org.au](http://www.community-life.org.au), prepared a set of Best Practice Guidelines for running suicide prevention activities and will be establishing an information and support service.

Dissemination of information and the Best Practice Guidelines is being planned for the next phase in 2004-5 through a series of workshops around the country.

The project is keen to involve local stakeholders in this process.

### 1 Year Research Project Grant

A Rotary Club and the Australian Rotary Health Research Fund will jointly fund a one year research project grant.

If a Rotary Club agrees to contribute in "Funding Partners" - project grants - the ARHRF will advertise the availability of a research grant in the geographical area local to the Rotary Club.

### 'FUNDING PARTNERS' continued...

A Funding Partners research project grant will total a minimum of \$30,000 or a maximum of \$60,000 for the annual grant. The grant will be paid over a one-year period. Half the grant will be paid by the Rotary Club and half by the Australian Rotary Health Research Fund. 10% of all grants would be retained by the Australian Rotary Health Research Fund for advertising and administration expenses.

The total amount available for all outside funding would be limited to a maximum of \$150,000 per annum from the Australian Rotary Health Research Fund.

## 'Drop-in Centre'

The Southern Peninsula Mental Health Group has been developed in recognition of the needs of people with a mental illness. The SPMHG is a joint project between the families of people with a mental illness, the Mental Health Services and the local community. Rye Rotary invited speakers from the group and decided to support this project under Community Service. Rotary made an initial grant of \$500 to start the centre. This group played a significant part in the first Mental Health Forum on 8th August, 2003 and at present has two Rotarians Barry Irving and Zoe Sterling active on

The centre has now been in operation for several weeks with a growing number of regular and visiting clients. The drop-in centre itself is in the Anglican Parish Hall in Rye. The staff are a mix of professional consultants and volunteers. Professional staff coming from Peninsula Health, Peninsula Support services, Anglicare and Mental Illness Fellowship. The volunteers are mostly caring persons from the wider community. Part of ongoing planning is to include training programs for all volunteers by qualified personal.

The drop-centre is providing a long needed service that other communities could also provide. Rotary will and have given an undertaking to continue to help fund the centre as well as a 'Food for the Needy' program that we have been donating to for some time.
